

## Off Center and Eccentric Turning Between Centers



If you're looking for something to get your mind working on a cold winter day try off center or eccentric turning between centers. You don't need any special tools or chucks, just a drive, live center and a spindle gouge. You can make turnings of discovery or learn from articles and books. Turnings of discovery are fun, just don't use pricey wood.

To do discovery turnings; mount your wood either off center or eccentric and make some cove and bead cuts. Remount do some more cuts and see what results you get. You can mount the wood parallel off center or with twisted points at random or predetermined locations. Be sure to make notes if you want to duplicate your results. Just go for it and have some fun.
